

Reading List Project / Digital Library

The reading list is a list of recommended reading that is maintained by the Valley and provided to the membership via the Valley library and a virtual library assessable through the Valley web page. The reading list consists of two major aspects:

1. The books are reviewed by the membership. They can provide a short (one or two paragraph) review of the book. There should be a method for new reviews to be added to the reading list (either on line or collected by the Valley Secretary).
2. The list is managed by the Valley and the books are recommended for different subjects. This would include recommended order of reading so a new student can benefit from the experience of earlier readers.

This program would go hand in hand with other education programs and support research at the independent level of personal interest reading as well as at the formal level of presentation of research at stated meetings.

This would be a living document that will require some level of commitment to maintenance and updating.

Valley responsibilities:

1. Collect and maintain the book reviews.
2. Make the reviews accessible to the members
3. Make the materials (books, articles, and papers) available to the membership via the Valley library and the digital library.
4. Maintain the Valley web site and ensure the list is up to date and accessible.
